

Corporate Philanthropy



MCEC is a world-wide organization that identifies the challenges that face the highly mobile military child, increases the awareness of these challenges in both military and educational communities and initiates and implements programs to meet the challenges. MCEC's goal is to level the educational playing field for military children wherever they are located around the world and to serve as a model for all highly mobile children. The organization's commitment is to help families, schools and communities be better prepared to support children during these frequent moves and difficult - sometimes traumatic -times in the life of military families. MCEC's total effort is "for the sake of the child."
